



## **Board Registration Credit Policy Standard of Practice**

The Wranglers recognize the time, leadership, and service commitment required of board members. This policy establishes a clear and transparent structure for registration credits earned through active board service.

This policy applies only to approved board members in good standing.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

To qualify for registration credit, board members must:

- Attend a minimum of 75% of scheduled board meetings per year, unless an absence is excused due to participation in another official Wranglers activity or event.
- Actively fulfill the duties of their assigned role
- Participate in organizational planning and key events
- Contribute meaningfully to board initiatives and decision-making
- Remain in good standing with the organization

Board positions are working leadership roles. Holding a title alone does not qualify a member for registration credit. Credit is earned through active participation and measurable contribution.

Failure to meet these requirements may result in reduction or forfeiture of credit.

### **Registration Credit Structure**

#### Tier 1 – Executive Leadership (Up to 100%)

This tier applies to all board members serving in formally designated roles with assigned duties and responsibilities, excluding At-Large members.

Eligible roles may include, but are not limited to:

- President
- Vice President
- Treasurer
- Secretary
- Sport Commissioner (current sport season only)
- Head Coach (sport in season only) serving in an official board role

#### Tier 2 – At-Large Board Members (Up to 75%)

At-Large Board Members may receive up to 75% of base registration fees per season.

**Note: Eligibility for registration credit is contingent upon meeting all board participation and performance expectations as outlined by the organization. Final determination of credit allocation remains at the discretion of the Wranglers Board.**



## **Multi-Child Structure**

Registration credits shall be applied as follows:

- The approved percentage may be applied to eligible athletes within the same household, not to exceed one (1) athlete per season.
- Any additional athletes beyond two (2) shall not be eligible for additional board credit unless expressly approved by a vote of the Board.
- Credits shall apply solely to the lowest base registration fee associated with the entry-level program and shall not be applied to higher-tier or competitive program fees, nor to any supplemental, optional, or ancillary costs, including but not limited to uniforms, tournaments, equipment, or additional fees.

## **Probation & Removal**

Board members who fail to meet attendance, participation, or performance expectations may:

- Be placed on probation by majority Board vote.
- Have registration credit reduced or revoked
- Be removed from their board position in accordance with organizational bylaws

Registration credit is contingent upon continued active service throughout the **year**.

## **Conditions**

- Credits apply to base registration only (no travel fees, or optional add-on costs unless otherwise approved).
- Credits apply to the current season only and do not carry over.
- All credits must be approved by a majority vote of the Board.
- The Treasurer will document all credits for financial transparency.
- This policy will be reviewed annually.
